PRESS RELEASE **Ballot Propositions** **22 October 2018**

The City of Lago Vista has seven (7) propositions that appear on the November ballot. Each of the propositions are directly related to amending the City Charter. The City Council appointed a Charter Review Committee that made recommendations to the Council for consideration. City Council held a series of meetings and public hearings to discuss, debate and review each proposition before narrowing the list down to the seven items included on the ballot.

This is a brief breakdown of each proposition:

Prop A: This proposition will amend the City's annexation and dis-annexation abilities to mirror the laws of the State of Texas.

Prop B: This proposition will remove the Mayor from being the Chief Executive of the City and will place that authority in the position of the City Manager.

Prop C: This proposition will clarify that the Council, including the Mayor, only has power as a body to take action, unless otherwise stated within the Charter.

Prop D: This proposition will designate the City Manager as the Chief Executive and administrative officer of the City.

Prop E: This proposition changes the rules for general elections within the City. It states the requirements that candidates must adhere to in order to be included in the election.

Prop F: This proposition removes the Board of Adjustment's authority to consider variances and hear appeals regarding the building code.
